# HEADQUARTERS THIRD UNITED STATES ARMY G-3 SECTION 11TH SPECIAL FORCE DETACHMENT

5 September 1944

SUBJECT: Relationship with 11 S. F. Detachment

TO: Colonel Michelin Chef FFI, Region M

- l. Third Army has now left the area under your command. Although I will still maintain liaison with you and your command from time to time, nevertheless I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for the efficient and courteous manner in which you effected all transactions with me and members of my detachment.
- 2. The organization and control of the very diversified elements within your command left me with a feeling of great admiration for a most difficult task well accomplished. I thoroughly understand the difficulties under which you are functioning, among other things the fact that your leaders under your command have only recently been able to come out into the open, the fact that you have always been short of arms and ammunition, and the fact that the tasks requested of you by Third Army required very rapid action and left little time for the perfecting of details. In spite of these handicaps I consider that the tasks requested of you were accomplished in such a manner as to be of great assistance to the combat efforts of the Third United States Army. The assistance rendered is fully recognized at this headquarters.
- 3. While any Germans are left in the territory under your control these tasks will, of course of necessity continue, but I know that you will continue to see that they are accomplished with the same efficiency that you displayed in commencing them.

Col Michelin, Commanding Officer, Chef de Region M, FFI, #2 Rue St. Guillaume, RENNES.

- The bearer of this letter, Major Shallcross, is the Commanding Officer of the 13th Special Force Detachment, an organization attached to the 9th U.S. Army similar in function to the 11th Special Force Detachment commanded by myself.
- 2. Major Shallcross will establish contact with you to assist you in your problems in every way possible. He is authorized, like myself, to speak for General Koenig and will be your medium for attempting to iron out the knotty problems of arms distribution and P.C.L. supply. He also will be in a position to strengthen your liaison contacts with Communications Zone. Please consider him in every way as you considered me, including the receipt from him of any tasks that may be desired to support the Army to which he is attached.
- 3. I believe it would be adviseable to establish limison with him similar to that which you established with me. Since so great a distance separates us, and Major Shallcross's detachment is very close to you, I am sure that many of the problems I was unable to finish can be solved by him.

4. My compliments to yourself and your officers with hopes that we will meet again in the not too distant future.
